FREE OPIOID CE COURSES

In our continued response to the opioid crisis, physicians are actively engaged in education efforts to improve our capacity to reduce addiction in Virginia. As part of these education efforts, Virginia now requires all licensees of the Board of Medicine to obtain 2 hours of controlled substances Type 1 CE within the 24 months prior to license renewal. Type 1 CE hours are those that can be documented by an accredited sponsor or organization sanctioned by the profession.

MSV recognizes the importance of connecting physicians to quality and easy to access CE to ensure that all physicians are able to fulfill this requirement. MSV has compiled a list of free online CE courses that qualify to meet this new requirement. Please note that this list is not inclusive of all qualifying CE courses.
